## **GLUE – Session 1 – Creation**

1. In the beginning
Human beings are creative – creativity defines us as human beings.
Genesis = Beginning
Read Genesis Chapter 1
2. Thing Number 1 - Creativity
Human beings are made in the image of God.
When God makes humans all we know about God is that God makes stuff – that he is creative.
Creative is not just 'Creative Arts'
Why do you think God says <i>our</i> image rather than <i>my</i> image?
3. Thing Number 2 - Chaos
Creativity is bringing order out of chaos.
Natural Water in the Bible is often a symbol of chaos.
Humans are called to use our God-given creativity to bring order out of chaos in the world.
Can you think of or remember any Bible stories that involve large bodies of water – e.g. seas or lakes? Can you think what they symbolise?
4. Going deeper
Walter Brueggemann calls the creation story in Genesis a 'theological affirmation'.
Genesis is not a scientific document.
We see the world through a lens – called a worldview – ours is modern/scientific.
Genesis was written in a pre-modern worldview.
Why do some people get sidetracked into arguing about creation and evolution?
