## **GLUE – Session 5 – Church**

## 1. What is Church? God had come in the person of Jesus and somehow made humans spiritually clean so that God's presence could come and live in them. Church is not a building, nor is it a bunch of people sitting in pews singing Victorian hymns on a Sunday morning! Q. When someone says church what do you think of? 2. Remember the Temple?
